

Three Warnings About the Tongue

- Those who use their mouths to teach God's Word will be judged more strictly. (3:1)

- The tongue is the most difficult part of the body to control. (3:2)
 - This is why teachers will be judged more strictly.
 - This isn't just true for teachers, it's true for everyone.

- Even though the tongue is small, it's super powerful. (3:3-5)

Three Ways to Respond to these Warnings

- Confess the ways in which you've stumbled and not controlled your mouth.

- Look to Jesus as your substitute and perfect representative.

- Let the grace you've been shown in Christ transform your heart and mouth.
