- We sing because singing is one of the results of being filled with the Spirit (5:18)
 - If singing is the result of being controlled by the Spirit and you're not singing, then ask yourself, "what is controlling me then?"
 - If singing is the result of being controlled by the Spirit then we're not dependent on a specific music style or taste to compel us to sing.
- We sing to teach and encourage one another. (5:19)
 - We sing so that we can teach each other.
 - We sing so that we can encourage each other.
- We sing to praise and glorify the Lord. (5:19)
 - We want to praise him for who he is (his attributes).
 - We want to praise him for what he's done (his saving acts).
- We sing to express the emotions in our hearts. (5:19)
