- We're not to love money. (5:8-17)
 - The love of money can lead to the mistreatment of others. (5:8-9)
 - Money is unable to satisfy you. (5:10)
 - Money is never problem-free. (5:11-12)
 - Money can increase the number of "mouths" we feed. (5:11)
 - Money can decrease the amount of sleep we get. (5:12)
 - Money is fleeting. (5:13-16)
 - Money can be lost at any moment. (5:13-14)
 - Our money will ultimately be lost when we die. (5:15-16)
 - The love of money can make you miserable. (5:17)
- We're to view money as a momentary gift from God to enjoy, rather than lasting gain to love. (5:18-20)
 - God has given us the gift of work to enjoy. (5:18)
 - God has given us wealth and possessions to enjoy. (5:19-20)
