- We have a dragon (Satan) seeking to devour us. (Rev. 12)

 - He will have a mysterious name. (19:12)
 - He will be clothed with a bloody robe. (19:13)
 - He will be called the Word of God. (19:13)
 - He will be accompanied by armies of heaven. (19:14)
 - He will have a sharp sword in his mouth. (19:15)
 - He will rule with a rod of iron. (19:15)
 - He will tread the winepress of the fury of his wrath. (19:15)
 - He will be the King of kings and Lord of lords. (19:16)
- Jesus is going to defeat all those who oppose him and his bride, the church. (19:17-21)
 - An angel will summon all the birds of the air to the great supper of God's judgment. (19:17-18)
 - The beast and false prophet will be captured and thrown into the lake of fire. (19:19-20)
 - All the rest who oppose Jesus will be slain and eaten by the birds. (19:21)
