- The sin of partiality is contrary to the royal law. (2:8-9a)

- The sin of partiality declares you a transgressor of the law. (2:9b-11)
 - Transgressors of the law are guilty.

 - Transgressors of the law dishonor God.

- The sin of partiality demonstrates the condition of your soul. (2:12-13)
 - Believers obey God's law.

 - Unbelievers don't obey God's law.
