

Three Differing Responses to Who Jesus Is

- The Pharisees and Sadducees still don't understand who Jesus is. (16:1-4)

- The disciples forget and don't remember who Jesus is or what he's done. (16:5-12)

- Peter confesses that Jesus is the Christ, the son of the living God. (16:13-20)
 - This confession is divinely revealed to Peter. (16:17)

 - This confession is the foundation on which the church is built. (16:18)

 - This confession is the means by which Peter (and the church) have authority to exercise the keys of the kingdom. (16:19)
