



Three Observations About the Cycles of Times That Make Up Our Lives (3:1-8)

- All of life is made up of cycles of times.
- The times of life are a mixture of highs and lows, ups and downs, pluses and minuses.
- The different times of life offset each other.

Two Main Lessons We Should Take Away from These Observations (3:9-11)

- Because life is made up of cycles of times, there is no lasting gain in anything we do. (3:9)
- These cycles of times teach us that there is a sense in which we are workers in this life, but there's another, ultimate worker. (3:10-11)
 - There are things that God has given us to do. (3:10)
 - God is the one who actually makes everything fitting and right in its time. (3:11)
 - God has given us a sense that he's doing something bigger than we can see right now, but we can't fully grasp everything he is doing. (3:11)

How We Should Live in Light of the Cycles of Life (3:12-13)

- Be joyful. (3:12)
- Do good. (3:12)
- Eat and drink. (3:13)
- Take pleasure in your work. (3:13)
- Live like all of life is a gift from God—because it is! (3:13)
