

Two Sad Tragedies

- The tragedy of unenjoyed possessions. (6:1-2)
 - If you're able to enjoy the money and possessions God has given you, then that's a gift from God!
 - If it's a tragedy to not enjoy the money and possessions God has given you, then enjoy them!
- The tragedy of never being satisfied. (6:3-9)
 - A stillborn child is better off than someone who lives a long life but is never satisfied. (6:3-6)
 - God has given us wealth and possessions to enjoy. (5:19-20)
 - A stillborn child is at rest, while a man who is never satisfied is not. (6:4-5)
 - A man who lives his entire life unsatisfied and a stillborn child end up in the same place. (6:6)
 - It's better to be content with what you have than unsatisfied and striving after what you don't have. (6:7-9)

One Humble Response

- Since God is sovereign over this life under the sun, we shouldn't argue with him and his ordering of the world. (6:10-12)
