

Two Final Examples of How Our Righteousness Must Exceed the Scribes and Pharisees

- Our righteousness must exceed the scribes and Pharisees in how we judge. (7:1-6)
 - We should be careful about judging anyone because the standard we use to judge others will be used to judge us. (7:1-2)
 - There are times to correct one another as Christians for each other's good, but we must make sure we're seeing clearly first so we can actually help each other. (7:3-5)
 - We should be especially cautious about trying to hold outsiders to the standard of righteousness of kingdom citizens. (7:6)
- Our righteousness must exceed the scribes and Pharisees in how we ask. (7:7-11)
 - We should ask like needy children who have a really good Father.

One Guiding Principle that Sums Up the Righteousness that Exceeds the Scribes and Pharisees

- Do to others what you wish they would do to you. (7:12)
