

The Superiority (and Limitations) of Wisdom

- An example of wisdom:
 - By his wisdom a poor man saved a little city from the attack of a mighty king and his army, yet no one remembered him. (9:13-15)
- The lesson we learn about wisdom:
 - Wisdom is better than might. (9:16-18)
- The limitations of wisdom:
 - Wisdom is oftentimes despised for its source. (9:16)
 - Wisdom can be subverted by a little bit of folly. (9:18, 10:1)

The Characteristics of a Fool

- A fool's heart is inclined toward sin. (10:2)
- A fool is easy to pick out. (10:3)
- A fool fights folly with folly. (10:4)
- Fools are often put in high positions. (10:5-7)
