

The Overarching Point

- Faith without works is useless, it can't save. (2:14)
- Just as words without actions don't do a poor person any good, so words without actions don't do a professing Christian any good either. (2:15-17)

The Implications For Our Lives

- It's possible to profess faith in Jesus and not be saved.
- If you have genuine, saving faith, then your faith will be fruitful.
 - Jesus is the basis of our salvation.
 - Faith is the means of our salvation.
 - Genuine, saving faith is more than just believing Jesus' life, death, and resurrection are true.
 - Genuine, saving faith trusts in and relies on Jesus' life, death, and resurrection as your only hope for salvation.
 - Works is the evidence of our salvation.
