

Three Key Things to Remember

- Apocalyptic literature is often symbolic and not chronological. (1:1; 5:5-6,8)
- We are currently experiencing the tribulation. (1:9; 2:9)
- True Israel are those who are circumcised of the heart, who have placed their faith in Jesus — not ethnic Jews. (2:9; 3:9)

Four Revelations About the End Times

- God will pour out his wrath. (7:1-2)
- God has sealed those who are his. (7:3-9)
 - Those whom God has not sealed will not stand.
 - Those whom God has sealed will stand.
- God is the possessor of salvation with the Lamb. (7:9-14)
 - God is sovereign and worthy to be praised.
 - The Lamb cleanses God's people.
- God will one day wipe away every tear from the eyes of those who are his. (7:15-17)
 - Those who are his will get more of him.
 - Those who are his will have no lack.
 - Those who are his will live forever.
