### The Purpose of Teaching in Parables

- Jesus taught in parables to both conceal and reveal truth. (13:10-17)
  - For those who rejected Jesus as the Messiah, the parables concealed truth and pronounced judgement. (13:11-15)
  - For those who accepted Jesus as the Messiah, the parables revealed truths of the Kingdom. (13:16-17)

### The Point of the Parable of the Sower

- The soils represent four different types of heart level responses to hearing the message of the kingdom. (13:3-8, 18-23)
  - The disinterested heart (13:4, 19)
  - The disingenuous heart (13:5-6, 20-21)
  - The distracted heart (13:7, 22)
  - The distinguished heart (13:8, 23)

### The Proper Responses to the Parable

- Don't harden your heart. (13:9, 12b-15)
- Be grateful for your salvation. (13:10-12a, 16-17)
