- Watch your step when you come into God's presence. (5:1)
 - We should watch our step when we come into God's presence because he is God and we are not. (5:2)
 - The appropriate way to relate to God as we live this life under the sun is to approach him with reverent fear. (5:7)

Two Practical Ways to Watch Your Step When Relating to God

- Use your ears. (5:1)
 - Appropriate fear of God causes us to come into his presence ready to listen and obey, not just to participate in religious activities.
- Be cautious about using your mouth. (5:2-7)
 - If we don't fear God, we will be tempted to speak too quickly to him. (5:2)
 - If we don't fear God, we will be tempted to be too wordy when speaking to him. (5:3, 7)
 - If we don't fear God, we will be tempted to speak flippantly to him. (5:4-6)
